

## Introduction

BC Transit, the District of Squamish and the Resort Municipality of Whistler offer transit service for Squamish residents commuting to and from Whistler. Schedules may be periodically adjusted due to highway construction.

The schedule is designed to meet shift start and finish times at Whistler (8am, 3pm, 4:30pm, 5pm and 11pm). This special service offers a blend of options between Sea to Sky Transit and Greyhound Flexpasses plus an emergency ride home program in case of employee emergencies.

## Transfer Policies

Passengers are permitted transfers to and from local transit in Whistler or Squamish. Special monthly passes are also valid on both Sea to Sky Transit and local services. Passengers using Sea to Sky Transit for local Squamish service pay regular Squamish Transit fares.

## Transit Tax Credit

You can save on each monthly bus pass you purchase by claiming a tax credit on your income tax return. Simply keep your monthly pass and dated receipt, and print your name on the back of the pass. For more information, visit:

## Greyhound Service

Greyhound service leaves from the Whistler Intercity Bus Loop on Village Gate Boulevard and from Squamish at the Greyhound depot.

## Regular Greyhound fares apply.

Transfers are not issued. Greyhound commuter tickets (Flexpasses) can be purchased at further discount (20 tickets/\$90) at Whistler and Squamish Municipal Hall. Greyhound tickets are not accepted on Sea to Sky Transit. Sea to Sky Transit tickets/passes are not accepted on Greyhound.

## Strollers on Board

On accessible low-floor buses the stroller can be wheeled onto the bus with the child in the stroller. Once on board remove the child from the stroller, fold the stroller and store it between the seats making sure it is clear of the aisle. When the wheelchair space is available, you can leave the child in the stroller. The stroller's brakes should be set, but the wheelchair restraining straps are not required.

On buses with steps, please take your child out of the stroller before boarding the bus and store the stroller between the seats.

The parent or guardian is required to hold onto the stroller at all times.

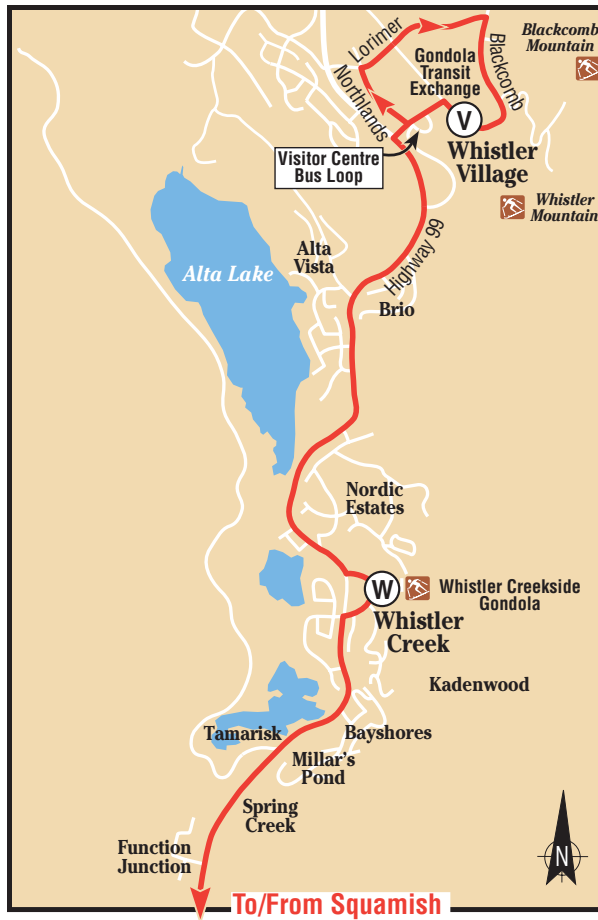

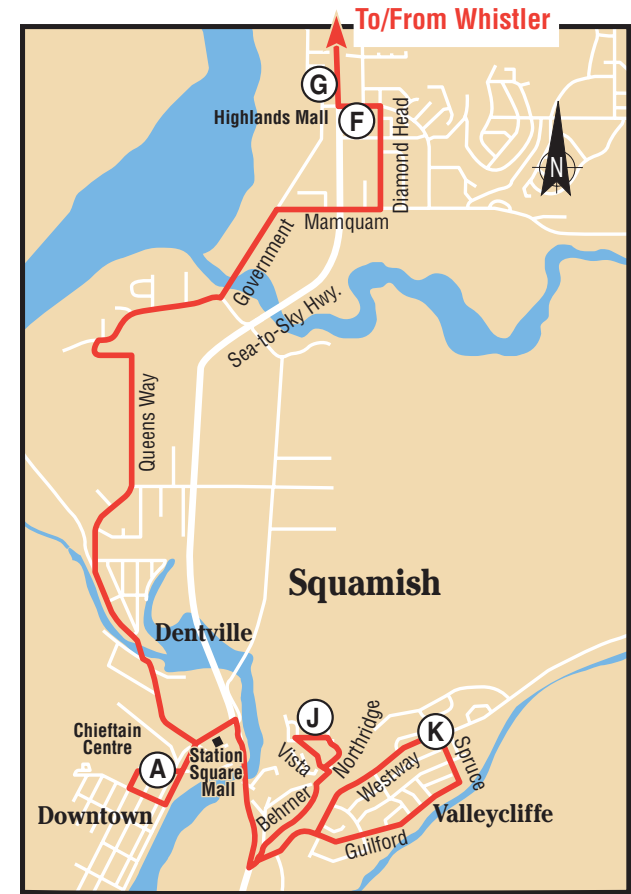


### Emergency Ride Home

The Emergency Ride Home program is for commuters who regularly use the Sea to Sky Transit System. In case of an emergency, this program gives you a guaranteed ride to your destination.

### How Do I Use Emergency Ride Home?

If you used the Sea to Sky Transit System and an emergency arises while you are at work that day, just call a taxi. Ask the taxi driver for a receipt of the fare paid, not including the tip.



Send the original receipt along with a completed application form to the Resort Municipality of Whistler, 4325 Blackcomb Way, Whistler, BC, V0N 1B4.
