**SIMULATION MODELLING**

A computer analysis that simulates traffic movements on a given road network and identifies localized issues that affect capacity of the system

**PRELIMINARY BUSINESS CASE**

A document based on analysis that provides the strategies for moving the project forward in a rational and effective way

**DETAILED BUSINESS CASE**

The document that lays out the project parameters of scope, schedule and budget, and provides the means and agreement for moving forward with project implementation
